- If your scheduled collection day falls ON OR AFTER a weekday holiday, your collection will be one (1) day later that week.
- If your scheduled collection day falls BEFORE a weekday holiday, there will be NO change in your pick up.
- Place carts, with handles/wheels toward house, on a level area at curb within 4' of street.
- Leave 3' clearance around all sides of cart
- Ensure lids are closed to prevent water/snow from collecting in container.

Items to be included in your recycling cart:

Aerosols 	Clean foil 	Large tins

Do I need to shovel the snow and ice from my sidewalks?

Yes. Grove City Borough Ordinance #793 requires that property owners, their tenants and business owners must clear sidewalks within 5 hours after the end of a snowfall or before 10AM for snow that has accumulated overnight.

Property owners, tenants and business owners need to shovel their sidewalks on all sides of your property, the full width of the sidewalk down to the bare pavement. Remove all ice from sidewalks. After the sidewalk is clear, a sprinkling of sand can help prevent slipping on frosty sidewalks. Pile snow onto your yard or the area between the curb and sidewalk. It's against the law to shovel snow into streets or alleys. If you have a corner property, clear curb cuts at the corners and crosswalks to the street gutter.

Will I get fined if I don't?

Yes. If the Borough gets a complaint or discovers that a sidewalk is not properly cleared, the Code Enforcement Officer will inspect the sidewalk and give the owner a chance to clear it. If the sidewalk has not been cleared upon re-inspection, the property owner may be issued a citation with a fine. Borough Crews will remove the snow and ice from the sidewalk and property owners will be billed for the service with an additional charge of 10% plus face possible fines.

Do I need to clear the snow away from the fire hydrant in my yard?

Yes. The Grove City Volunteer Fire Department reminds you to clear snow away from any fire hydrant in your neighborhood. In an emergency, every second counts. Please shovel a three foot area around fire hydrants.

I still have leaves in my yard and some small sticks and branches.

Will the Borough still pick those up?

Once the Borough places the snow plows on the trucks, leaf collection will end. You can always take your leaves and small yard debris to the Lawn Debris Recycling Center at the end of Greenwood Drive by the Waste Water Treatment Plant. The yard debris collection will begin again the second Friday in April.

What can I do with my Christmas tree?

The Borough will pick up your Christmas tree after the holidays, but you will need to take it to one of the parks listed below for pickup. Please do not put it to the curb,

Tri-County nor the Borough will pick them up.

Located at the corner of Rainey Ave and Summit St

Hunter Farm Playground in Ward 2

Located at the end of Greenwood Dr

Union Street Playground in Ward 3

Located at the corner of Gilmore St and Union St

McConnell Street Playground in Ward 3

Located at the corner of McConnell St and Dale St

Terrace Avenue Playground in Ward 4

Located at the corner of Terrace Ave and W Washington Blvd

Stewart Avenue Playground in Ward 5

Located at the end of Stewart Ave

I'm doing some remodel work on my property. Can I put the construction debris in my garbage?

A small amount of construction debris can be placed at the curb. Generally, the debris should be stacked or bundled in lengths no longer than 4 feet and no larger than 2 feet in diameter. The equivalent of two 45 gallon cans of C&D waste per week can be taken at the curb. For larger amounts, residents need to contract with a waste hauler to dispose of their construction debris.

Why didn't the TV I set out with my garbage get picked up?

The Pennsylvania Covered Device Recycling Act prohibits disposing of televisions, computer monitors, desktop & laptop computers and other covered electronic devices in a landfill. Covered devices must be properly recycled.
