GROVE CITY BOROUGH RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES PLEASE RETAIN THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

UNLIMITED SERVICE - ITEMS THAT WILL BE PICKED UP AT THE CURB:

- ✓ Household Solid Waste - Includes all garbage, refuse, rubbish, animal and vegetable matter that was used for human consumption; excess fruits from trees on residential properties but not from trees on farms and/or orchards. It shall also include waste such as rags, paper and packaging materials, glass, crockery, bottles, leather, rubber, plastics and other household refuse. All cans, bags and containers shall be limited to 45-gallon capacity, and must be waterproof, sealable and of sufficient strength to permit rough handling, and shall not exceed seventy (70) pounds when filled with refuse. **It's important to make the containers visible to the driver! In the winter months, please remove snow from the area where you will place your containers and have a reasonably clear approach path to the containers both for the vehicle and the driver.** Drivers will not reach into the can to remove loose items that are frozen to the bottom.
- ✓ All carpets, rugs and padding must be cut in sections no longer than forty-eight (48") inches in length, securely rolled and tied, and weighing no more than forty (40) lbs.
- ✓ Small and large household appliances (appliances containing Freon must have proper certification for collection. If the Freon has not been removed, we will need the Make, Model, and Serial# **on the appliance in order to schedule the pickup. The removal of the Freon and certification will be an additional charge.**)
- ✓ Small quantities of material from household repairs (For larger projects Tri-County offers roll-off boxes ranging in size from 12 to 40 yards. Please call customer service for pricing or more information 724-748-4705.)

ITEMS NOT INCLUDED AND WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:

- ✓ Paving materials, stones, rocks, sand, dirt, broken concrete, large automobile parts (including batteries), sod, metal grease drums and concrete washtubs
- ✓ **Propane and oxygen tanks, gun ammunition, explosives or fireworks**
- ✓ **Due to fire hazards, we cannot accept ashes**
- ✓ Due to state regulations we CANNOT accept excrement, flammable liquids (solvent, paint thinners, oil, containers holding liquid paints, gas, kerosene or any liquids), auto batteries, or any material that may be considered hazardous, infectious or toxic including medical and radioactive waste.

NEEDLES AND SHARP OBJECTS: Help us prevent needle sticks to our employees. Place all needles, syringes and lancets, in a hard plastic container with a tight fitting lid taped shut. Put these with your regular trash, NOT the recycling. Wrap all sharp objects, such as broken glass or sharp metal in heavy paper and tape them shut. **Please help us protect our workers!**

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE: We observe the following holidays on the days on which they fall.

New Year's Day Memorial Day Independence Day Labor Day Thanksgiving Day Christmas Day

WE DO NOT OBSERVE: Martin Luther King, Jr. President's Day Columbus Day Veterans Day

If your scheduled collection day falls on or after a weekday holiday, your collection day will be one (1) day later that week.
If your scheduled collection day falls before a weekday holiday, there will be no change in your collection day.

Collection days are as follows:

South of and including Main St (State Route 58)
Collection Day is MONDAY

North of Main St (State Route 58) Shaded Area
Collection Day is THURSDAY

Exception: All Streets off of Main St west of Highland Ave are MONDAY Collection
