2023 Memorial Park Pool Rules

- All patrons must present a valid season pass or pay the daily admission rate upon entering the pool.
- Max Occupancy of pool is 125 patrons for the 2023 Season.
- Swim Test: Performed by the Pool Supervisor or Senior Life Guard. Wristbands will be issued as follows:
 - Red Wristband Shallow End Only Non-Swimmer
 - Yellow Wristband Middle Section and Shallow Section Only
 - Blue Wristband All Areas of the Pool Including Diving Boards (must be able to swim (2) widths of the pool using the crawl stroke without stopping or toughing the bottom of the pool)
- The Community Pool is a tobacco free facility; smoking/tobacco use is prohibited. This includes Vape's and Juul's.
- Alcoholic beverages or persons under the influence of alcohol/drugs will not be permitted in the pool complex, surrounding areas or any part of the park. The police will be called immediately.
- The use of abusive or profane language or other improper conduct on pool/park property shall be grounds for expulsion.
- All children that are not toilet trained are required to wear specifically designed swim diapers and appropriate swim wear. Caretakers must provide own swim diapers.
- No dogs, cats or other pets are allowed within the pool complex unless classified as a service animal, credentials
 must be provided to verify this.
- Running, pushing, dunking and horseplay are strictly prohibited.
- Diving, is only allowed from the diving boards. NO diving from the side of the pool.
- Children under the age of 9 must be supervised at all times by a responsible person age 13 or over.
- Only Bubble (provided by staff) or water wings or are permitted in the pool complex. No other devices are allowed.
- Patrons are requested to leave valuables at home. The management is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Patrons are not to visit or engage in unnecessary conversations with lifeguards while they are on duty.
- Pool staff reserves the right to make a request of a patron regarding issues not written explicitly in the rules. Please keep in mind that the staff has patron safety as the primary consideration.
- Disobeying pool staff will result in immediate ejection from the pool facility.
- If the pool is closed for more than 1 hour due to weather, a pool pass will be issued for another day's use within the 2023 season.

Please remember....the life guards are present to provide an additional level of oversight and safety for the pool, and have full authority to enforce the pool rules so everyone has a safe and enjoyable summer. Please help them out and respect their authority. Also, THEY ARE <u>NOT</u> YOUR BABYSITTERS. Parents and guardians are still fully responsible for knowing the whereabouts and actions of their children and guests.
